Wilson Center Building, Lobby and Theater Protocols

- Masks are required for all staff, cast members, and their families (ages two years and older) to enter the Wilson Center for the Arts and must be worn (covering both nose and mouth) at all times. Please bring your own mask. Anyone not in compliance will be asked to leave the building. For the health and safety of all patrons, we ask all individuals to wear a mask regardless of their vaccination record.
- Staff will have their temperature taken daily before entering the Wilson Center and are required to wear masks while in the building.
- The use of a face shield will be only be permitted in combination with the wearing of a face mask.
- All persons will have a temperature check at entry. Those who have a temperature will be asked to wait outside for 5 minutes and rechecked before being admitted or denied entry.
- Additional cleaning staff will be cleaning surfaces every day.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be located throughout the lobby area.

Finale on June 11th from 5pm to 6 pm

- There will be limited seating for families of the cast member due to the need for social distancing which allows for 2 persons per cast member only.
- Your finale seating regarding the location of 2 specific seats will be sent to you.
- Your closest entry point to your seat location will be determined by the ushers to reduce lines at the doors and in the aisles.
- No more than two people will be allowed into the elevator at one time.
- All protocols outlined above will be mandated, including mask wearing at all times while in the Wilson Center Building for all family members.
