- Application is due by Tuesday, May 7. Please email forms to wilson-center@fscj.edu
- There will be a **Mandatory Parent Meeting on Tuesday, May 14, 2024 at 7 p.m.**
- **Technician Orientation is Thursday, June 6 at 10 a.m.**
We will go over the work schedule, crew assignments, etc. A safety video will be shown followed by an exam.
- Scene shop and tool training will be scheduled for the week of June 10, schedule is to be determined.
- Regular shop hours will begin the week of June 17.
- Tech weekend will be Saturday, July 13 - Sunday, July 14
- Dress rehearsals are July 15 - 18 and will be held in the evenings.
Anyone running the show is required at tech weekend, all dress rehearsals and all performances.
- **If you have any conflicts July 13 - July 21 or July 25 - July 28, please call and speak with Ashley Geisinger.**
